ED7 Report – October 15, 2016

1. Comprehensive review of legal, privacy and governance concerns as they relate to data sharing
2. Recommendations on how to make data generated by state agencies more accessible and usable by state government and the public as open data
3. Recommendations for data sharing governance, ethical use and authority
4. Recommendations of key analytics projects providing the highest likelihood of realizing value demonstrated by cost savings and better outcomes



ED7 – Additional Directives

1. Review all commonwealth systems, practices, processes, policies, applicable laws and regulations governing the sharing of data across agencies
2. Create an inventory of state agencies' data analytics assets, capabilities, best practices and data-sharing activities
3. Create a common data sharing lexicon and terminology to eliminate friction and confusion among state agencies
