

**PSAP Grant Program  
Decision Brief**

**1. Briefly define the problem/issue:**

Greenville County is seeking an emergency grant from the Board in the amount of \$150,000 to replace their CHE. The locality has received an End of Notice Support letter from their maintenance vendor effective February 28, 2018. Maintenance support for Greenville's CHE will end on this date unless the locality proceeds with required upgrades.

**2. Background** (include important dates):

The locality does not plan to upgrade their current CHE because preliminary price quotes indicate that upgrading the CHE would cost more than replacing it. Greenville has submitted an FY 19 grant application to replace their CHE with a Vesta system as part of their ongoing commitment to work with the City of Emporia towards consolidation. Emporia currently uses the Vesta system.

**3. Major Considerations:**

The request does not meet the criteria of an emergency grant. The request must be for a critical PSAP item that is no longer functioning in its entirety. CHE is a critical PSAP item, but it is still functioning and has support through February 28, 2018.

**4. Recommended action:**

**Staff does not recommend approval of the request.**

**5. Alternatives to recommended action:**

The locality can resubmit for an emergency grant when service is no longer available.
