Summary

- Microsoft products and quantities provided by Northrop Grumman as part of its services and fees, and included in VITA's rates, were reviewed and adjusted as part of renewing Northrop Grumman's enterprise agreements with Microsoft
 - Commonwealth and agencies have responsibility for "non-core" Microsoft products
 - Project, Visio, Streets & Trips, MapPoint, Visual Studio and subscriptions
 - VITA and Northrop Grumman working with Microsoft and SHI to transfer licenses and agencies' election of software assurance based on business need
 - Northrop Grumman maintains responsibility for "core" Microsoft products
 - Microsoft Office Professional, operating system, CoreCAL
 - Server, SQL



Status and Next Steps

- Agencies will be provided with transfer documents for the licenses from Northrop Grumman's prior enterprise agreement
- Additional counts recorded as obtained from SHI
- Reports with by-workstation installations
- Agency may need to supplement with its procurement records if gaps exist
- Northrop Grumman and VITA establishing reports to assist agencies with responsibility for compliance
