Transition Update

- Negotiations are very close to completion
 - Transition services agreement (TSA) is nearly ready for signatures
- Challenges of the TSA
- Interagency agreements were sent at the end of October; please return if you haven't
- The interagency agreement (IA) needs to list all VI services
- The IA needs to be signed and returned to VITA



Agency Planning

- Start your planning **now**
 - VITA is creating deployment packages
- Very important not to wait until April and May to transition
- Drafting communiqué to agency heads to make them aware of the urgency of the situation
- Requests for your application data must come to VITA



Agency Planning

- Agencies need to be transitioned by June 30
- The commonwealth must be aware of the possibility that VI resources and support may begin to wind down after June 2013
- If you foresee any requirement, need, special exemption to go beyond June 30, please talk to us **NOW**



Requests For VI To Make Changes

- Requests granted on an exception basis
- Requests for VI to change or modify production websites and applications must be approved by VITA eGov Services
 - Agencies are strongly encourage to engage new vendors first



Hosting Governance

- Criteria for governance is on the VITA eGov Services pages
 - Adhering to IT Security Standard SEC 501, meeting compliance, both agency and supplier
 - Describing how protecting data is foremost in governance approval
 - Personnel and sensitive data is weighed heavily to remain within the COV domain
