# Building Adoption


- Training - build HHR agency support; several training sessions coming in March; how to use the tool; process workflow
- Requests from additional agency and external partners to join the E-MOU Coordinating Committee; in talks now

# E-MOU v2 Coming

- Enhancements to include other Secretariats, local government agencies and interested commercial partners
- Some topics that need to be enhanced include appeals, warranties, size of the Coordinating Committee
- Targeting OAG review after the Legislative Session work settles down (late March)

# Program Overlaps – Virginians Served

The illustration below provides population overlaps of individuals served by Medicaid, SNAP, and TANF in Virginia.



- Most TANF recipients also receive Medicaid and SNAP benefits
- Half of Medicaid recipients also receive SNAP benefits
- One in every five Virginians receive SNAP, TANF or Medicaid

Program	People Served Annually
Medicaid	1,273,438
SNAP	1,298,999
TANF	144,465
