



Geospatial Services Annual Rate Structure for State Agencies – FY 2009

November 15, 2007

Effective July 1, 2008, the Virginia Geographic Information Network (VGIN) has established Fiscal Year 2009 rates for state agencies to access base mapping data for Virginia. These data are collected and maintained by VGIN and provided as a service through the following rate structure. All fees are annual and based upon the state fiscal year. Subscribers to the service will always receive the most current statewide data available for that service.

Virginia Base Mapping Program (VBMP) Products & Services

Orthophotography and ancillary products

- High Resolution Imagery Web Service:	\$20,000
- High Resolution Imagery – GeoTiff data format:	\$75,000
- High Resolution Imagery – MrSID data format:	\$50,000
- One Meter Imagery Web Service:	\$10,000
- One Meter Imagery – GeoTiff or MrSID data format:	\$30,000
- Digital Terrain Model:	\$25,000
- Contour Data (where available):	\$5,000
- Structure Data (where available):	\$5,000

Additional Base Map Data Layers

- Road Centerline (RCL) data:	\$4,200
- Additional GEP basemap layers:	\$2,400

Definitions

- “High Resolution” is defined as two foot, one foot or six inch ground resolution per pixel.
- “One Meter” is defined as one meter ground resolution per pixel.
- “Imagery Web Service” is defined as an ESRI or a WMS (Web Map Service) compliant orthophotography web map service.
- “Structure Data” is defined as building outlines or footprints on the surface of the earth.
- “GEP”: Geospatial Enterprise Platform, a collection of enterprise servers and software used for Geographic Information Services (GIS).

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
