Request from VA PSAPs

- During the NG9-1-1 Feasibility Study town hall meetings, local public safety communications officials expressed their desire for a greater voice, representation, and input into the work plan and program of the E-911 Services Board

Purpose

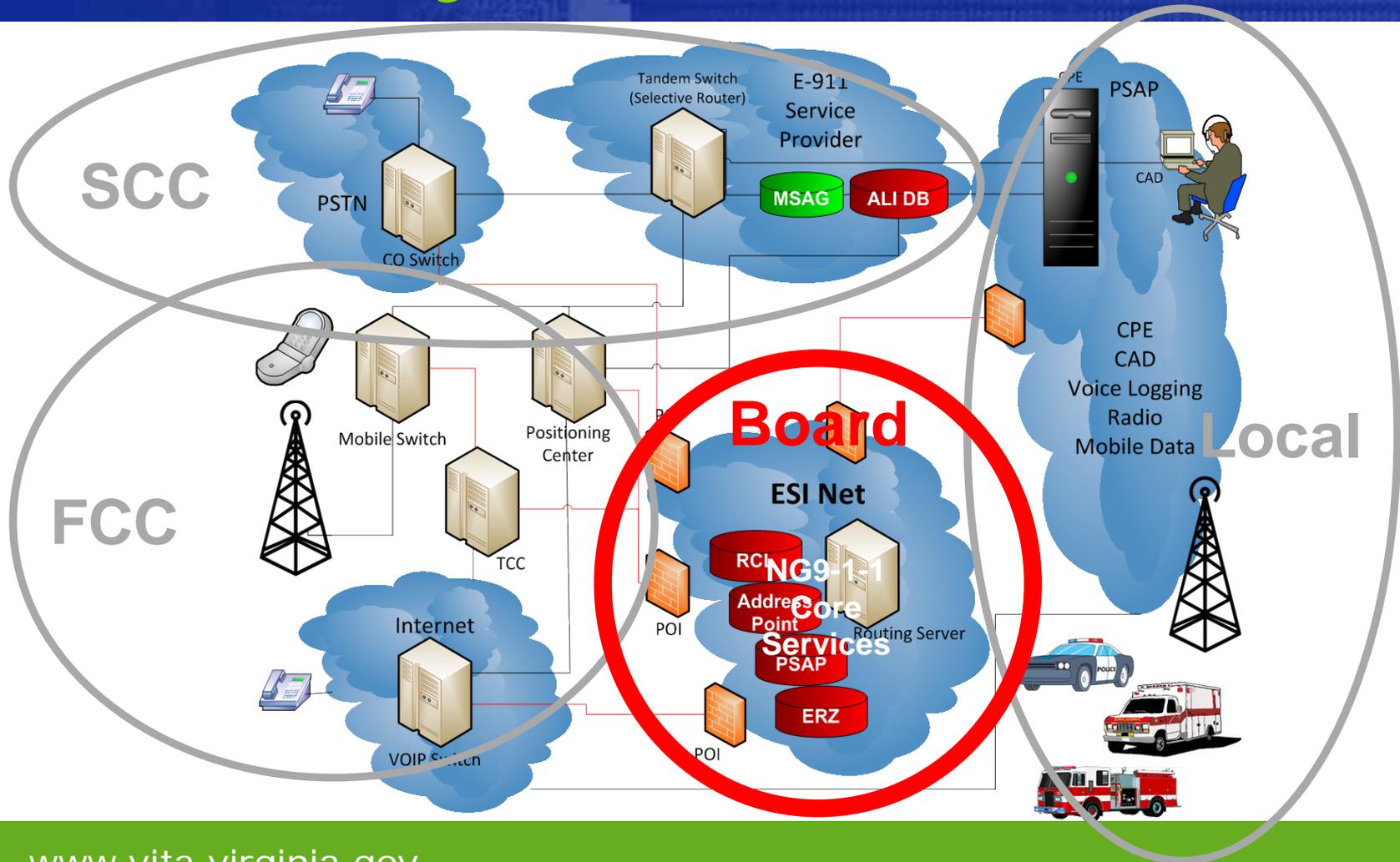




High Priority Tasks

- Feb 10th RAC Meeting:
 - Consensus interpretation of Plan's Goals and Initiatives
 - Created a list of recommended tasks related to 9-1-1 ecosystem
