PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Provide a detailed description of the project for which funding is being sought, including the impact on operational services and consequences of not receiving funding; the relationship to local strategic and capital improvement plans; and sustainability:

The computer aided dispatch system replacement project will install a full new CAD system solution for the County. It is anticipated that the system will deliver, at a minimum, four CAD positions, two administrative positions, configuration specific to Nelson County's requirements, an integrated map display, addressing tools for use in ArcGIS, texting and faxing capability and remote access to records via smartphone. New hardware including a CAD server and workstations will be provided.

Nelson County's current CAD system is technically outdated and will become non-vendor supported in approximately three years. Support of the system is currently limited and no upgrades to the current software will be offered. This system must be replaced within the three year period of remaining maintenance coverage. Additionally, concerns exist regarding the current level of support and its continuation over the three year period.

Replacement of the current CAD meets Nelson County's strategic planning goal to routinely cycle through the replacement of aging systems to keep pace with the most current technology and utilize highly reliable systems in providing 911 services to the public.

Nelson County is committed to pay any cost related to the installation and implementation of the system that is not covered by grant funding, however full funding for the project without assistance from the PSAP grant program will be difficult to obtain within the required timeframe. Nelson County will ensure that the system is covered under a maintenance and support agreement for the life of the system.



PROJECT GOAL

Describe how this project addresses locally identified need(s) and supports the Virginia 9-1-1 Comprehensive Plan:

This project will meet Nelson County's goal to replace a technically outdated and marginally supported CAD system that has been in use for more than eight years. The County's current CAD vendor is no longer in business and support will only be available for approximately three more years through another company that assumed this role. The County also has concerns regarding the level of support currently available and the possibility that this support will become increasingly degraded or eliminated as fewer and fewer customers continue to use the system.

This project will support the goals of the Comprehensive Plan by replacing outdated infrastructure with a system that will provide for reliable and secure performance that meets the expectations for level of service in the Commonwealth. The system will provide for greater use of GIS data in the CAD environment to better locate and improve response to calls. The system will also provide improvement in capabilities related to information sharing with other localities.

The grant funds will be used to procure a new CAD system that meets Nelson County's needs. A vendor budgetary quote is attached to provide information and pricing on anticipated features, however final system functionality will be determined during the procurement process. It is anticipated that the system will deliver, at a minimum, four CAD positions, two administrative positions, configuration specific to Nelson County's requirements, an integrated map display, addressing tools for use in ArcGIS, texting and faxing capability and remote access via smartphone. The quote includes five years of vendor support and maintenance. Additionally, quotes are provided for four pc workstations and a CAD server that are required hardware for the system.
