



Enterprise Architecture (EA) Taxonomy Change Control

Process

- Any stakeholder can propose additions or modifications of a domain taxonomy (ea.virginia.gov)
 - Identify taxonomy domain (Business, Information, Solution, & Technology) & version to be changed
 - Describe the proposed change (what section of the taxonomy)
 - What is driving the change?
 - Scope & impact to agency, commonwealth
 - Risk of making/not making the change
- Domain Architect reviews request
 - Must review within one week of receipt
 - Determines level-of-effort to change taxonomy
 - Changes must conform to [EA Taxonomy Standards](#)
 - Makes recommendation
- Change Control Board review
 - Domain Architect schedules review within two weeks of recommendation
 - Domain Architect chairs meeting
 - Stakeholders that are Responsible & Accountable may vote on proposed change
 - Based on approval, timeline established for application of change
- Domain Architect
 - Implements change to taxonomy
 - Publishes new version
 - Sends notification of change to stakeholders
