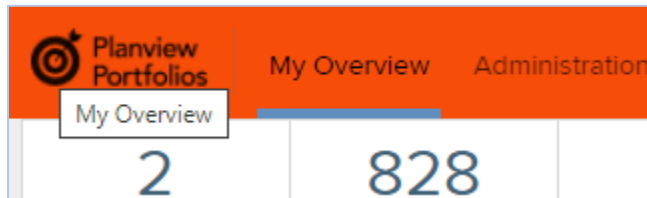


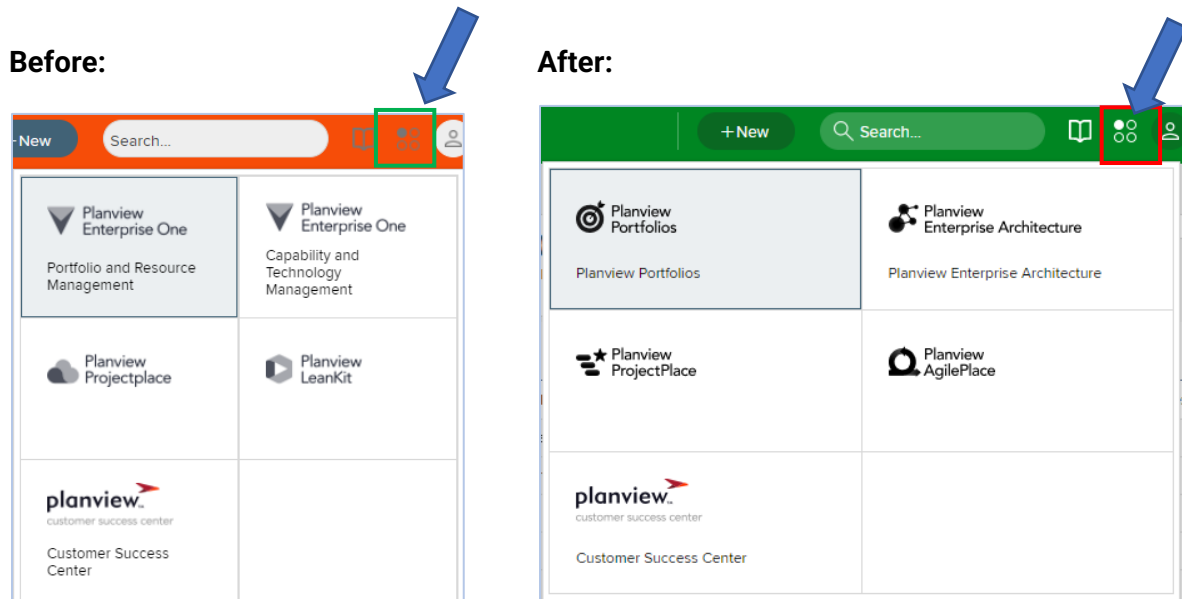


1. Application names/logos updated:

a. The main logo (top, left):



b. on **Application Selector**:



2. Multi-column sort

To sort data by multiple columns:

1. Click the relevant tile on the ribbon.
2. Press the **Shift** key, then click the first column header by which you want data to be sorted.
3. Click additional column headers while continuing to press the **Shift** key to add those columns to the set of columns being sorted. Repeat this process to add more columns to the sort order.
4. If a column is already in the set of columns being sorted, clicking its header while pressing the Shift key toggles the sort direction (ascending vs. descending).

To remove a column from the set of columns being sorted, click the column's header while pressing the Ctrl key.

TIP

To identify the order in which the columns you selected are being sorted, the application displays a number next to each selected column's header. For example, if you sort the data by the **Schedule Start** column and then by the **Schedule Finish** column, the application displays a 1 by the **Schedule Start** column header and a 2 by **Schedule Finish**. An icon (such as ↓ or ↑) also appears in the column header to indicate the direction of the sort.

Example: **Portfolio View**, using **Portfolio Manager** tile, sorting first on **Investment Type**, then on **Investment Approval Status**, then on **Item Classification Governance**

3. Rows are taller.

Example below shows prior release (September 2022) and the new release (October 2022), side by side. The zoom on both is 100%. (Screen shots are to show line size differences...data does not necessarily match.)

- Font appears larger and each line appears space a little further apart.
- Fewer lines are visible in the same amount of space

4. Cell & row selection/hover indicator

Multiple row selection only looks a little different.

A side-by-side comparison shows the difference between the September 2022 release and October 2022 release when selecting multiple rows.

- Dark line around entire selection, not each individual cell.
- Dashed underline under editable field when hovering over it.
