This is Amendment No. 114 to the Comprehensive Infrastructure Agreement between the Commonwealth and Vendor originally dated as of November 14, 2005 and as subsequently amended (hereinafter, "Amendment No. 114"). The Commonwealth and Vendor have agreed to modify the Comprehensive Infrastructure Agreement as set forth below. Except as expressly modified in Amendment No. 114, the terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. Capitalized terms used but not defined in Amendment No. 114 shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Agreement.

1. In Appendix 5 to Schedule 3.3 (Desktop Computing Services SOW), a new Section 3.1.10 is added as follows.

**"3.1.10 Oracle Java Runtime Environment Workstation Software Update Deployment**

Vendor will deploy Oracle Java Runtime Environment application version releases that are issued to the public at no additional charge to an existing Eligible Customer desktop computing infrastructure as specified in this section (hereinafter, "Java Update"). Vendor and VITA will agree on a deployment schedule, which will not exceed one deployment per quarter; however, in the event of a specific and verifiable Java security threat, VITA's Commonwealth Security and Risk Management (CSRM) may direct a Java Update. An Eligible Customer must request a Java Update in addition to scheduled deployments as mentioned above, or an update to any Eligible Customer-installed version of Java Runtime Environment, through the Work Request process and such update will be priced separately in accordance with the Agreement.

After a Java Update is deployed to an Eligible Customer, any request for a Java version downgrade due to an incompatibility with an Eligible Customer's software will be completed through the Work Request process and subject to IMACs for PCs Resource Unit fee. Downgrades and update exclusions must be CSRM-approved exceptions; incremental patch updates are not available.
