See below for key highlights from the meeting worth reiterating.

Security

Use of Acunetix 360 is required and needs active participation from you.

Vulnerabilities will stay “Present” on your reports until a remediator has marked the issue as “Fixed (Unconfirmed).” Each issue must be updated and actively rescanned if automatic retesting is not available. The status will only update to “Fixed (Confirmed)” after the remediation has been validated.

- Critical and high vulnerabilities that are marked as “present” for more than 30 days will appear to be out of compliance, whether or not they have been fixed. You must confirm the fixes within Acunetix 360.
- Information security officers - contact VITA's security team at commonwealthsecurity@vita.virginia.gov to request Acunetix 360 for your team members.

Architecture

Architecture review is required for all new sites or sites undergoing architecturally significant changes.

Architectural significance is defined in the enterprise architecture standard (EA225) as “a concern, problem or system element that has a wide impact on the structure of a system, or on its important quality properties such as performance, scalability, security, reliability or evolvability.”

- **Significant:** re-platforming, adding features/functionality, etc.
- **Not Significant:** adding content, images, etc. to existing structures.

Software requests
