## **Accessibility**

First up on maturing how we work -- PDF accessibility!

Join Michelle Pinsky during accessibility office hours nextWednesday, Jan. 17 at 10 a.m. for a special topic seminar: *PDF Accessibility 101 – What it is and how to do it.* 

The seminar will teach participants the importance of PDF accessibility and why it's important for meeting compliance guidelines for state agencies. The seminar will feature a step-by-step tutorial on how to make PDFs accessible in Adobe Acrobat, as well as provide free printable cheat sheets and checklists for participants to take back with them on their accessibility journey.

#### Siteimprove

Speaking of accessibility training, we onboarded over 130 developers to Siteimprove Frontier and the Accessible Virginia training platform in December. Siteimprove Frontier will finish rolling out our custom training credentials the week of **Jan. 22**, after which all remaining Siteimprove users will be added to the platform.

With your Frontier account, you will have access to custom web developer, web designer and content contributor training. All users will have access to all training, so you can dive into anything that will assist you in your job duties.

ACTION ITEM: Raise your hand! Accessibility training isn't just for Siteimprove
users. If your agency has content creators, or anyone who would benefit from
learning more about accessibility, they can sign up for Siteimprove Frontier
using the <u>WebMod Software Request form</u> on VITA's service portal. We are
currently using about 350 of our 800 seats. We'll be monitoring requests to fill
the remaining seats while ensuring all agencies have access to the training.

## **Analytics**

Interested in learning more about website analytics? Join us for a webinar with the Siteimprove team where they will cover the analytics module and its features, how to implement the code on your websites and the training available to all Frontier users.

#### eGov Contracts

Manny Liban, our eGov Service Manager, worked hard with our supply chain partners over the holiday and has been able to amend our existing contracts with AISN and SiteVision.
