Security Vulnerability Reporting

All agencies have been converted over to VITA's new, cloud-based instance of Acunetix. With web modernization, we are highlighting security, but VITA's security policy has not changed. All critical and high vulnerabilities are to be remediated within 30 days of first being scanned.

Agencies that fail to remediate issues in that timeframe will begin to receive notifications from VITA. In addition, VITA's enterprise architecture is developing an automated process to create security exceptions in Archer. Expect more partnership and engagement from your agency-assigned enterprise architects as issues are identified and tracked through to remediation.

We've previously discussed Siteimprove, Siteimprove Analytics, Fusion / JAWS Inspect, and Google reCAPTCHA. Please continue to reach out with any questions. Next up is Elasticsearch (https://www.elastic.co/). Elastic currently powers the enterprise search functionality in the Commonwealth branding bar. Soon you will be able to leverage it directly on your websites. Elastic will help improve search engine optimization and fine-tune search results with custom algorithms, allowing end users to have a more targeted experience when using your website's search functionality.

The vendor will be assisting with implementation, training, and support for Elasticsearch. Please reach out today if you are interested so we can begin prioritizing agencies for implementation.
