PSAP Grant Program Metrics

- In order to measure the performance of the PSAP Grant Program, ISP is in the process of establishing performance metrics. Performance of the PSAP Grant Program is currently defined as the ability to meet the needs of the PSAPs.



PSAP Grant Program Metrics

- ISP will review the past three funding cycles for data on the following critical grant priorities:
 - CHE
 - GIS Data (including GIS High/Medium/Low)
 - GIS/Mapping Hardware/Software (including primary mapping system)
 - CAD
 - Text to 9-1-1
 - Voice Logging
 - Other (all other grant program types)



PSAP Grant Program Metrics

- Using priorities data, ISP will begin to create metrics based on the following data elements:
 - Number of grants awarded for critical grant program priorities
 - Number of grants awarded by region
 - Number of grants awarded by grant type (individual and regional/shared services, including number of PSAP participants)
 - Number of grant applications for which funding was not received by region, priority type, and grant type
- Based on year and aggregate data results

- Additional data elements will be added based on input received from the PSAP Grant Committee.
