9-1-1 Data Analytics Project Path Forward





Problem Statement

- Minimal data collection currently
- No performance data on existing network
- Guiding principle to not degrade service
 - Need to be able to monitor system performance
 - Need a baseline of service before NG9-1-1



Solution Path

- Critically important that we have a data supported understanding of:
 - Current functional levels of 9-1-1; operationally and systematically,
 - The impact of NG9-1-1 services on those functional levels.
- Standard reporting tool across PSAPs, that provides consistent, comparable data analytics. ECaTS solution.



Board Action and Direction (3/12/16)

- Request \$1M allocation of existing budgeted funds – **Approved**
- Goals – Deploy ECaTS statewide
 - Start data collection ASAP
- Further resolve the Data Sharing Agreement
 - FOIA & Records Retention
- Deployment methodologies considered
 - Voluntary or Mandatory



Data Sharing Agreement – access levels

1. Unrestricted access to all ECaTS reports
or

2. Access to limited reports including:

- **Call Summary Report**
- **Calls per Hour**
- **Top Busiest Hours**
- **Average Call Duration**
- **Calls by Circuit**
- **Circuit Utilization**
- **PSAP Answer Time**
- **Class of Service**
- **Call Transfer**
- **Outage**
- **Wireless Call Sector**
- **Wireless Transfer Summary**
- **Ad-Hoc Reporting Tool**

Note: Reports in red would be aggregated statewide.



Data Sharing Agreement – Data Requests

- Final Data Sharing Agreement
 - The PSAPs are the owners/custodians of the data
 - FOIA/Requests for Data
 - Board/ISP will refer data requestors to the PSAP(s).
 - PSAPs respond to requestor based on their data sharing policies and decision-making.
 - Requests that come to the Board/staff for aggregate or statewide data will be responded to in accordance with the Board's and VITA's policies and decision-making.



Data Sharing Agreement – Data Retention

- Final Data Sharing Agreement
 - The PSAPs are the owners/custodians of the data
 - Records Retention
 - Each PSAP responsible for ensuring their data held in ECaTS is preserved, maintained, and accessible throughout the lifecycle of the data.
 - Each PSAP is responsible for making decisions regarding retention and destruction of data in ECaTS and regarding creation and retention of local copies of data in ECaTS.
 - Board/staff will offer advice.



Continued Planning & Outreach

- Developing Implementation plan
 - Coordination and education (PSAPs, state, vendor)
 - Installation timeframe and scheduling
 - DSA review and signing
 - Roles and responsibilities
 - Procedures; “to do” lists



Staff Recommendations

- Approve Data Sharing Agreement
 - Authorize ISP Director to sign for Board
- Approve Conditionally Mandatory Implementation
 - Based on Board financing
 - Failure to participate results in PSAP Grant Program ineligibility
 - Exception process
 - Based on considerable hardship of the PSAP
 - PSAP must be able to provide necessary data.
 - Board approval required for exception.



FY 18 PSAP Grant Guidelines





NG9-1-1 GIS Project Definition

- Must relate directly to the preparation of data based on approved NG9-1-1 data standards, applicable data models, or GIS best practices and include a data maintenance plan
- These projects should not include any day to day geospatial maintenance activities
- Allowable items include those related to data production (enterprise software/hardware, GIS tools, data format conversion and manipulation) and data transfer



NG9-1-1 GIS Project Grant Ranking

- Grant ranks for NG9-1-1 GIS projects have been added:
 - Shared Services projects are Rank 15
 - Individual PSAP projects are Rank 16



Mission Critical NG9-1-1 GIS Data

- Only NG9-1-1 GIS projects that focus on the following data categories will be funded:
 - boundary issues
 - road centerline
 - address points
- These components are the three most critical components of developing NG9-1-1 data



Priorities

- Priority 2: NG9-1-1 GIS
 - Replaces “NG9-1-1 GIS Data”
- Priority 3: Mapping System
 - Replaces “Mapping System and GIS Equipment”



Definition of Mapping System

- Includes servers, mapping display workstations, and software and miscellaneous hardware associated, if purchased separately to support the maintenance of NG9-1-1 data



GIS Matrix

- GIS Matrix has been eliminated
 - No longer relevant or of value
- ISP staff will provide examples of NG9-1-1 GIS projects that are eligible for funding



Geo-Diverse Approach

- The goal is to provide maximum system survivability and data traffic and bandwidth usage
- The applicant must justify the location of the required system servers
- A geodiverse network does not, and should not, require a server in every location
- Any exception to this must be justified in the grant application



Shared Services Projects

- Additional language added:
Shared services projects that consist solely of a network solution and only associated network equipment (switches, routers, network connections etc.) will be prioritized as a Strengthen (tier level) project



Memorandum of Understanding

- An MOU is a formal document that guides and directs the parties of a Physical Consolidation Project in regards to their affiliation and working relationship, inclusive of anticipated future arrangements, for the purposes outlined in the grant application submitted by the parties



Multi-Jurisdictional Agreement

- An MA is a formal document that guides and directs the parties of a Shared Services Project in regards to their affiliation and working relationship, inclusive of anticipated future arrangements, for the purposes outlined in the grant application submitted by the parties



Other Definitions

- Removed all footnotes and included information in Definitions section:
 - CHE
 - Must be NG9-1-1 ready, as defined in the guidelines. Network projects, that exclude CHE or ESInet and next generation core services (NGCS) capabilities, will not be funded individually. ESInet and NGCS are considered a part of the CHE project. UPS can be purchased only with CHE, Mapping or CAD projects and must be “workstation” grade, not facilities grade. Time sync can be purchased separately from CHE.
 - Text-to-9-1-1
 - Non-Allowable Items



Call Accounting/MIS

- Recommending that Call Accounting/MIS grants only be considered for funding with an exception:
 - Board has already approved funding a statewide solution



Other items

- New PSAP Grant Committee meeting schedule
- 30-day follow-up period
- Business day deadline for PEP reimbursements
- New Travel Assistance and Meals & Incidental Expenses changes
 - PEP application also updated
