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# No Wrong Door Expansion for Adult Protective Services

- Already Used by Area Agencies for Aging and Their Private Sector Partners
- A Grant Proposal to the Administration for Community Living will:
- Leverage the NWD approach and case management application functionality already used in Virginia for APS workers
  - Share assessment, eligibility, services and outcomes information across NWD agencies, programs and providers, including LDSS agencies APS programs,
  - Automate referrals to community based providers with information that expedites and improves the quality of service provision
- Standardize the electronic processes for APS workers to receive and respond to reports of adult abuse, neglect, and exploitation, engage in person centered service planning and possess online access to qualified providers in local communities whose services are closely aligned with client needs
- Use and integrate the National Adult Maltreatment Reporting System (NAMRS) case component data standards and key indicators so they are available to a data warehouse that aggregates LTSS data across community based programs in Virginia and the NAMRS database.

# Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Funding for NWD Expansion

- Make strategic changes to Virginia Navigator database to prepare for expanded utilization
  - Assign Alliance of Information and Referral Systems (AIRS) nomenclature to remaining categories of vendors and services in current provider directory; AIRS Taxonomy/ PeerPlace Realignment

  - Develop a standardized minimum data set for each data resource provider within participating HHR agencies
  - Determine the authoritative source for information on each service type when multiple data resource providers exist within participating HHR agencies

## Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Funding for NWD Expansion

- Implement interface between Virginia Navigator and EHHR Enterprise Data Management (EDM) to access real time information from data resource providers within participating state agencies through a virtual provider directory.

# Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Funding for NWD Expansion

- Expand the use of CRIA (Communication, Referral, Information and Assistance) by public and private LTSS "Servicing Providers" that provide services but generally do not make referrals.
  - Develop means to exchange eForms data with NWD System and other case management systems for providers receiving but not sending referrals (\*no cost\* to 'non-referring' provider)

# Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) Funding for NWD Expansion

## Community Needs Document

Integrate electronic Long-Term Services & Supports (eLTSS) standards into the NWD system to enable the exchange of standardized data for the creation and re-use of interoperable service plans for use by health care and community-based LTSS providers, payers and the individuals they serve.
