# Session Overview & EIA Alignment

- Business analytics depends upon availability of high quality data, defined and specified based standards and shared via compliant exchanges among partner agencies and stakeholders
- Implementation of enterprise information architecture strategies depends upon agency level data governance and formal roles for data stewards/data officers



# Session Overview & EIA Alignment

- Data sharing depends upon trust – trust that those partners in the exchange will meet shared requirements:
  - Statutory and regulatory requirements for security, privacy and informed consent
  - Legal requirements compliant with Applicable Law for the jurisdictions of the ecosystem
  - Common technical requirements and service specifications for security and confidentiality
